

At Cencreae, the peaceful port reminds us of purposeful journeys and the grace guiding our lives. Overnight in Athens.

Day 4 | Sunday | October 19th



During this day, as you visit the Lionadis Monument and the Lion of Amphipolis, reflect on the courage and strength these ancient symbols represent. They stand as timeless reminders of humanity's enduring spirit. Traveling to Kavala, the historic port where Paul brought his message of hope to Europe, invites you to embrace gratitude and faith, inspired by the landscapes and legacies that shaped this sacred path. Overnight in Kavala.

Day 5 | Monday | October 20th



During this day, as you tour Thessaloniki, feel the spiritual essence of its rich history. At Vlatadon Monastery, where Paul once preached, reflect on the enduring power of faith. The White Tower and Alexander Monument stand as symbols of strength and legacy, reminding us of the balance between earthly achievements and divine purpose. Mars Hill recalls Paul's message of divine truth, while Adrian's Arch and the Panathenaic Stadium echo the glory of human achievement. At Syntagma, the Zappeion, and the Presidential Palace, reflect on the balance of tradition and progress. Athens invites you to walk its timeless paths with a spirit open to wonder, wisdom, and connection. Overnight in Athens.

Day 1 | Tuesday | October 14th

Arrive in Santorini Prepare to be Enchanted! If time allows, in the afternoon visit the remarkable Akrotiri Lighthouse, marvel at the ocean views from Firostefani and Skaro Rock, and watch the sunset over the picturesque village of Oia. Free time.

Day 2 | Wednesday | October 15th



You will enjoy a Santorini Volcano and Hot Springs Boat Tour where you will visit the island of Palaia Kammeni and visit the hot springs, the famous mud baths, which were formed as result of a series of volcanic eruptions. In the small bay of Agios Nikolaos the water temperature ranges from 30 to 35 degrees Celsius, as it mixes continuously with the normal sea currents. You will have free time in the late afternoon to enjoy the enchanting sunset and views of Santorini.

Day 3 | Thursday | October 16th



Spend a full day discovering Santorini's ancient history, local culture, and famous views on this great-value highlights tour. Explore the Santorinian villages, visit the Red Beach, swim at the black-sand Perissa Beach, take in panoramic views from Prophet Elias Monastery, and learn details about the historical heritage of the island. Finish the day with an unforgettable sunset from Oia village.

Day 4 | Friday | October 17th



Late Morning departure to Athens. Rest and Relax and prepare to begin main tour.

Itinerary Post Extension

Day 1 | Friday | October 24th

Start the Post-Extension to the beautiful isle of Patmos. Travel from Athens to Piraeus to take the Ferry to Patmos. Ferry leave at nearly 6 pm.

Day 2 | Saturday | October 25th



Departing from Skala harbor, our tour will start by visiting the Grotto of St. John taking the form of a 17th century Monastery built around the cave where St. John spent two years living the life of an ascetic (95-97 AD). Under the influence of visions, St John wrote the Apocalypse, dictating it to his disciple Prochoros.

We then drive up to the most impressive village of Chora, the capital of the island. On top of the hill, lies the Monastery of St.

John, a Byzantine building, built in 1088 by the Blessed Christodoulos, servant of Christ. Dinner and worship*. Overnight in Patmos.

Day 3 | Sunday | October 26th



This day our tour, covering the south side of the island, not only giving you the opportunity of discovering hidden places but also an opportunity to photograph the most amazing land and seascapes. Our tour commences from the Port of Skala where we will be taken by bus to the old village of Chora, the island's capital and a photographer's paradise! We continue with a drive to the top of the mountain of Profit Illias, the highest point of the island - 269 meters above sea level where the panoramic sea and landscape views leave one speechless! Next we make our descending drive to Diakofti stopping off to photograph the view of the mystical rock of Petra and then on to a boatyard. An unforgettable experience - you will have a memory of Patmos and its life, recorded through your own personal experience..

Return to the Port of Skala. Overnight in ship (option to upgrade to cabins with shower and bathroom for \$150 per person) on Blue Star Ferry.

Day 4 | Monday | October 27th



Arriving at Piraeus Port at nearly 8:25 am. Transfer to Athens. Departure afternoon flight from Athens airport
