

Itinerary Main Tour

Gain greater insight into the history, geography and unique features of these historic, biblical places.



Day 1 | Sunday, March 15th

It's finally Departure Day for the Main Tour! Get ready to explore new destinations, make unforgettable memories, and embark on the journey of a lifetime. From the moment you step on board, excitement will be in the air! Pack your bags, grab your passport, and let's hit the road! Your next great adventure starts today.



Day 2 | Monday, March 16th

Welcome to Athens (ATH) – the cradle of Western civilization and a city where ancient history and modern life blend effortlessly. Upon arrival, you'll be embraced by the vibrant spirit of Greece's capital, home to iconic landmarks, lively streets, and timeless charm. This evening, we'll come together at the hotel for a welcome dinner and an opening meeting to introduce the tour, connect with fellow participants, and walk through the itinerary.



Day 3 | Tuesday, March 17th

Today, explore Athens, where history and faith intertwine. Visit Syntagma Square, Zappeion, the Presidential Palace, and the Panathenaic Stadium. Pass through Hadrian's Arch and ascend Lycabettus Hill for breathtaking views. Conclude at the Acropolis, reflecting on ancient glory and Paul's sermon at Mars Hill.



Day 4 | Wednesday, March 18th

Begin your journey in Corinth, where Paul preached and built a thriving Christian community. Walk through the ruins of the ancient city, stand at the Bema of Gallio, and reflect on his letters to the Corinthians. Visit Cenchreae, the port where Paul set sail, embracing the spirit of mission and faith. Continue to the city of Meteora. Overnight in Meteora.



Day 5 | Thursday, March 19th

Marvel at the sacred Meteora Monasteries, perched high on cliffs, a testament to faith and devotion. In Veria (Berea), stand where he taught the noble Bereans who eagerly received the Word (Acts 17:10-12), reflecting on the power of faith and scripture. Overnight in Thessaloniki



Day 6 | Friday, March 20th

Today, explore Thessaloniki, where Paul preached to the early believers, and visit the city's sacred sites. During the Afternoon you will enjoy some free time. Overnight in Kavala



Day 7 | Saturday, March 21st

Today, walk in the footsteps of Apostle Paul in Philippi, where faith triumphed over trials. Reflect at Lydia's Baptistry, the site of Europe's first Christian conversion. In Kavala, stand where Paul first set foot in Europe, embracing the call to share the Gospel.



Day 8 | Sunday, March 22nd

Departure Back home from Thessaloniki airport or start the Post extension. As your journey ends, take a moment to reflect on the spiritual connections and sacred history you've experienced. May the lessons and memories from this trip stay with you, guiding you on your way home. Safe travels

Itinerary Pre Extension

Day 1 | Thursday | March 12th

It's finally Departure Day for the Pre extension to Patmos! Get ready to explore new destinations, make unforgettable memories, and embark on the journey of a lifetime. From the moment you step on board, excitement will be in the air! Pack your bags, grab your passport, and let's hit the road! Your next great adventure starts today.

Day 2 | Friday | March 13th



Arrival in Athens-Transfer to Piraeus port where a boat will take you to your Patmos experience. Ferry leaves at nearly 6 pm. Late arrival in Patmos Island.

Day 3 | Saturday | March 14th



Departing from Skala harbor, our tour will start by visiting the Grotto of St. John taking the form of a 17th century Monastery built around the cave where St. John spent two years living the life of an ascetic (95-97 AD). Under the influence of visions, St John wrote the Apocalypse, dictating it to his disciple Prochoros. We then drive up to the most impressive village of Chora, the capital of the island. On top of the hill, lies the Monastery of St. John, a Byzantine building, built in 1088 by the Blessed Christodoulos, servant of Christ. Overnight in Patmos.

Day 4 | Sunday | March 15th



This day our tour, covering the south side of the island, not only giving you the opportunity of discovering hidden places but also an opportunity to photograph the most amazing land and seascapes. You will visit the old village of Chora, and continue to the top of the mountain of Profit Illias, the highest point of the island - 269 meters above sea level, where the panoramic sea and landscape views leave one speechless! Next we make our descending drive to Diakofti stopping off to photograph the view of the mystical rock of Petra. Overnight in ship back to Athens to start the Main tour.

Day 5 | Monday | March 16th



Arriving at Piraeus Port at nearly 8:25 am. Transfer to Athens to start the Main tour

Day 1 | Sunday | March 22nd

Arrive in Santorini Prepare to be Enchanted! If time allows, in the afternoon visit the remarkable Akrotiri Lighthouse, marvel at the ocean views from Firostefani and Skaro Rock, and watch the sunset over the picturesque village of Oia. Free time.

Day 2 | Wednesday | March 23rd



You will enjoy a Santorini Volcano and Hot Springs Boat Tour where you will visit the island of Palaia Kammeni and visit the hot springs, the famous mud baths, which were formed as result of a series of volcanic eruptions. In the small bay of Agios Nikolaos the water temperature ranges from 30 to 35 degrees Celsius, as it mixes continuously with the normal sea currents. You will have free time in the late afternoon to enjoy the enchanting sunset and views of Santorini.

Day 3 | Thursday | March 24th



Spend a full day discovering Santorini's ancient story, local culture, and famous views on this great-value highlights tour. Explore the Santorinian villages, visit the Red Beach, swim at the black-sand Perissa Beach, take in panoramic views from Prophet Elias Monastery, and learn details about the historical heritage of the island. Finish the day with an unforgettable sunset from Oia village.

Day 4 | Friday | March 25th
