## Day 1 - Monday, May 25<sup>th</sup>

Later, at the Tsukiji Outer Market, we'll wander through vibrant stalls filled with sizzling street food and ocean-fresh sushi, a feast for the senses. Before leaving the capital, we'll ascend the Tokyo Skytree, where sweeping views stretch across the vast metropolis, and on clear days, all the way to Mount Fuji. By afternoon, we board the legendary shinkansen bullet train, gliding at breathtaking speed through the Japanese countryside until we arrive in Kyoto, the ancient heart of Japan, where lantern-lit streets and centuries-old temples await.



## Day 5 - Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup>

### Timeless Kyoto
