

Rome, Italy

Day 4 - Friday - May 15th

Florence, Italy

Day 5 - Saturday - May 16th

Waldensian Valley, Italy

Today, journey to the Waldensian Valley and explore the historic town of Bobbio Pellice. Visit the Sibaud Monument, a powerful symbol of faith and resilience, and the Church of the Cave, a site of deep spiritual significance. Continue to Chanforan, where history and devotion converge, and Pra del Torno, a peaceful haven in this sacred valley. Overnight in the Waldensian region.



Day 6 - Sunday - May 17th

Annecy, France | Geneva, Switzerland

Today, visit the picturesque town of Annecy, often called the "Venice of the Alps," with its charming canals and serene lake. Continue to Geneva, where you will see the iconic Reformation Wall, a tribute to the leaders of the Protestant Reformation. Marvel at the stunning Jet d'Eau on Lake Geneva and visit the historic St. Peter's Cathedral, a symbol of spiritual and historical significance. Overnight in Annemasse, France.



Day 7 - Monday - May 18th

Zurich, Switzerland | Konstanz, Germany

Today, explore Zurich, starting with the Limmat River, where Felix Manz was tragically drowned for his faith. Visit the iconic Grossmünster, the church of Ulrich Zwingli, a key figure in the Protestant Reformation. Afterward, head to Konstanz, a historic town on the shores of Lake Constance, known for its medieval charm and spiritual significance. Overnight in Konstanz.



Day 8 - Tuesday - May 19th

Wartburg Castle, Germany

Today, journey to Eisenach and visit the historic Wartburg Castle, where Martin Luther translated the New Testament in just 11 short months, a monumental achievement that changed the course of history. Explore the castle's rich heritage and the surrounding beauty of the Thuringian Forest. Overnight in Weimar or Eisenach.



Day 9 - Wednesday - May 20th

Weimar and Wittenberg, Germany

Today, reflect on the deep spiritual significance of Buchenwald Concentration Camp, a solemn reminder of human suffering and resilience. Then, stand in the sacred space of All Saints' Church in Wittenberg, where Martin Luther's 95 Theses sparked a transformative movement of faith. End the day with a peaceful journey to Prague, carrying with you the profound history of faith and freedom. Overnight in Prague



Day 10 - Thursday - May 21st

Prague, Czech Republic

Today, we'll walk in the footsteps of the coronation procession of the Bohemian Kings, tracing their path from the historic Old Town Square to the majestic St. Vitus Cathedral. As we cross the Charles Bridge, the open gallery under the sky, we will arrive in the Lesser Town, where history, faith, and beauty converge in a timeless journey. Overnight in Prague.
