Itinerary Main Tour

Gain greater insight into the history, geography and unique features of this historic, biblical places.



Day 1 | Sunday, August 30th

Departure: Your Journey Begins

Set your heart on pilgrimage as you depart for the lands where faith was born. Ahead lies a tapestry of revelation, history, and breathtaking encounters that will deepen your walk with God.



Day 2 | Monday, August 31st

Into the Land of Promise

Upon arrival in Israel, you'll be warmly welcomed and assisted through airport formalities. Travelers may take an optional transfer to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Christ. That evening, gather for an opening dinner and orientation—meet your fellow pilgrims and prepare your heart for a transformative journey through the living landscapes of Scripture.



Day 3 | Tuesday, September 1st

From Herod's Coast to the Galilee of Jesus

Walk the ancient harbor of Caesarea, where Peter baptized the first Gentile believers and Paul boldly proclaimed the Gospel. Stand atop Mount Carmel, where Elijah called down fire from heaven.

Visit Nazareth, the hometown where Jesus grew in wisdom and stature. Conclude with a serene boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, recalling the miracles and messages that once calmed these waters.



Day 4 | Wednesday, September 2nd

Galilee: Heart of Jesus' Ministry

Reflect at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount.

Visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, remembering Christ's restoration of His disciple. Walk the ancient streets of Capernaum, "Jesus' own town."

Explore Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. End the day at Yardenit, a peaceful site of baptism and renewal.



Day 5 | Thursday, September 3rd

Heroes of Faith & Birthplace of Hope

Begin at Beit Guvrin, part of ancient Maresha—rooted in Judah's biblical heartland. Its caves whisper of the everyday life that shaped Israel's story. Continue to the Valley of Elah, where David's unlikely victory over Goliath echoes through the ages. Visit the Tomb of Samson, remembering the God-given strength of Israel's mighty judge.

In the afternoon, return to Bethlehem to honor the birth of Jesus at the Church of the Nativity and reflect at Shepherds' Field, where angels first proclaimed the Good News. A day of courage, prophecy, and fulfilled promise.



Day 6 | Friday, September 4th

Strongholds, Scrolls & the Lowest Place on Earth

Ascend Masada, the desert fortress of resilience and defiance. Explore Qumran, cradle of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Float in the Dead Sea, Earth's lowest point.

If time permits, pause at Jericho, where Joshua witnessed walls fall at God's command. Welcome the Sabbath at the Western Wall, immersed in ancient prayer and devotion.



Day 7 | Saturday, September 5th

Sacred Jerusalem

Visit the peaceful Garden Tomb, a moving witness to resurrection hope.

Walk the Mount of Olives, then descend into Gethsemane, where Jesus surrendered His will in prayer. Follow the Via Dolorosa, retracing His final steps to the cross.

Conclude with a visit to Bethany, home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus—and the site of one of Jesus' greatest miracles.



Day 8 | Sunday, September 6th

Exploring the City of David

Step into the Upper Room, the birthplace of Christian fellowship and mission.

Honor Israel's poet-king at David's Tomb.

Stand upon the Temple Mount, the focal point of worship for millennia.

Walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, emerging at the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed a man born blind.



Day 9 | Monday, September 7th

Farewell to the Holy Lands

Depart with hearts full and faith rekindled. Carry home the stories, teachings, and sacred memories from your extraordinary pilgrimage through Egypt, Sinai, and Israel—treasures that will enrich your walk with God for years to come.

Day 1 | Wednesday, August 26th

Departure

Your spiritual adventure begins as you depart for the lands where Moses walked, heard God's voice, and stepped into his divine calling.



Day 2 | Thursday, August 27th

Arrival & Fellowship Dinner

Arrive in Arabia and gather with fellow explorers for a warm dinner. Set your heart for the extraordinary journey ahead through the landscapes of the Exodus.



Day 3 | Friday, August 28th

Into Midian—the Land of Moses' Exile

Begin your expedition in the storied Land of Midian, Moses' refuge after fleeing Egypt. Explore Al-Bad', traditionally connected to Jethro, priest of Midian. Visit the mysterious "Caves" or "Tombs of Jethro," and a local museum offering insight into Midianite life.

Stop at the Well of Moses, remembering the moment Moses met Zipporah and the course of his life changed forever. End the day at the Red Sea crossing, watching the sun set as you imagine the waters parting for Israel.



Day 4 | Saturday, August 29th

Tracing the Exodus Route—Marah, Elim & the Split Rock of Horeb

Return to the Red Sea crossing with an optional shoreline snorkel or a boat ride (permit-dependent). View the site associated with Solomon's Pillar marker. Continue deep into the wilderness toward possible campsites of Marah, Elim, and Israel's coastal encampment.

Journey through the oasis-fed canyon of Wadi Tayyab Ism, and then stand before the dramatic Split Rock of Horeb, a towering formation some believe to be the rock Moses struck to bring forth water. Explore surrounding ancient dwellings, stone circles, and petroglyphs—including footprint carvings tied to Israelite wandering traditions.

As you traverse the broad plains, imagine the clash between Israel and the Amalekites under Moses' raised staff.



Day 5 | Sunday, August 30th

The Mountain of God & Transfer to Jordan

Experience the awe of standing at the base of the mountain many would argue is the real Mount Sinai—Jabal Maqla, in the Jabal al-Lawz range. See the proposed graveyard from the Golden Calf judgment, cow petroglyphs tied to the altar, the dried streambed where water once flowed from the mountain, the massive double-walled wells, and the altar site of Moses with its white marble pillars.

Stand on the great plain where the Israelites gathered to hear the Ten Commandments spoken by God Himself—a moment that shaped the covenant people forever. In the afternoon, transfer to Jordan, crossing into the land where prophets walked and where the final steps of Israel's wilderness journey unfolded.



Day 6 | Monday, August 31st

Journey Into Israel for the Main Tour

Begin the day traveling north through Jordan's biblical landscapes before crossing the border into Israel, where your main Holy Land tour begins.

Enter the land promised to Abraham and walked by prophets, kings, and the Messiah Himself—ready to continue your journey through the living pages of Scripture.

Day 1 | Monday, September 7th

Timna Park & Crossing into Egypt

Begin the day in the Negev Desert at Timna Park, home to breathtaking geological formations and Solomon's Pillars. Explore a life-size replica of the Tabernacle, illustrating God's dwelling among His people in the wilderness. Cross into Egypt and journey to a quaint, rustic monastery at the base of a sacred mountain in the Land of Midian. For those who wish, an optional climb to the summit can be undertaken the following morning. Reflect on the spiritual significance of this remarkable region.



Day 2 | Tuesday, September 8th

Optional Mountain Climb & Journey to Cairo

For those choosing to climb, rise early for an exhilarating ascent of the mountain, witnessing the stunning desert sunrise. After descending, enjoy breakfast and refresh before traveling to Cairo, carrying the awe-inspiring landscapes and rich biblical history of Midian with you.



Day 3 | Wednesday, September 9th

Biblical Cairo & Coptic Heritage

Discover the Coptic Christian heritage in Old Cairo, walking streets that preserve the faith of Egypt's earliest believers. Visit biblical sites and the NMEC Museum, exploring artifacts that illuminate Egypt's pivotal role in the Exodus story and biblical history.



Day 4 | Thursday, September 10th

Pyramids of Giza, Papyrus & Nile Boat Ride

Stand in awe before the Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx, marvels of human ingenuity intertwined with the land of the Pharaohs. Explore the Papyrus Museum, enjoy traditional shopping, and conclude with a serene boat ride on the Nile River, reflecting on Egypt's ancient history and its connection to God's unfolding plan.



Day 1 | Friday, September 11th
