### Rome, Italy

## Day 4 - Wednesday - November 4<sup>th</sup>

### Rome, Italy

Walk through sacred history as we visit the Appian Way, the Catacombs of Domitila, St. John Lateran Cathedral, and the Scala Sancta—where Martin Luther's faith was stirred. We'll also explore Vatican City, including St. Peter's Basilica and Piazza. A day of deep spiritual reflection and powerful moments.



## Day 5 - Thursday - November 5<sup>th</sup>

### Florence, Italy

Enjoy a scenic drive to Piazzale Michelangelo in Florence, with visits to the Rose Garden, Arno River, Ponte Vecchio, Piazza della Signoria, and the stunning Duomo of Santa Maria del Fiore. Then we'll travel to Torre Pellice to spend the night



## Day 6 - Friday - November 6<sup>th</sup>

### Waldensian Valley, Italy

Today, explore the historic Waldensian Valley with a tour of Torre Pellice. Highlights include the morning market in Bobbio Pellice and a visit to the Sibaud Monument—a tribute to faith and perseverance.



## Day 7 - Saturday - November 7<sup>th</sup>

### Waldensian Valley, Italy

Continue your journey through the Waldensian Valleys with visits to the Church of the Cave, the historic site of Chanforan, and the peaceful Pra del Torno—places rich in faith, courage, and history.



## Day 8 - Sunday - November 8<sup>th</sup>

### Annecy, France

Today, drive to Annecy, France, and visit nearby Geneva. Discover key sites of the Reformation including the Reformation Wall, St. Pierre Cathedral, Jean Calvin's Auditorium, and the iconic Jet d'Eau.



## Day 9 - Monday - November 9<sup>th</sup>

### Basel, Switzerland

Visit Basel, Switzerland, to see the grave of J.N. Andrews, the first official Adventist missionary. Then travel to Zurich to explore the Limmat River—site of Felix Manz's martyrdom—and Grossmünster, Ulrich Zwingli's church. End the day in Konstanz.



## Day 10 - Tuesday - November 10<sup>th</sup>

### Wartburg Castle, Germany

Today, visit the sacred Wartburg Castle, a place of refuge and spiritual significance, where Martin Luther found strength in his faith. If time allows, we will also explore the historic city of Erfurt, deeply connected to the Reformation and God's work in shaping history.



## Day 11 - Wednesday - November 11<sup>th</sup>

### Erfurt, Germany

Today, we visit Erfurt, a city rich in Reformation history, and reflect on God's work in the life of Martin Luther. We will also journey to Buchenwald, a solemn site of remembrance, and end the day in Wittenberg, where Luther's faith sparked a movement that changed the world.



## Day 12 - Thursday - November 12<sup>th</sup>

### Berlin, Germany

Visit Berlin, a city with deep historical significance, where we reflect on God's work throughout the ages. Then, we journey to Prague, a city rich in faith and history, where we'll explore the spiritual heritage that shaped this beautiful land.



## Day 13 - Friday - November 13<sup>th</sup>

### Prague, Czech Republic


