Day 1 | Thursday, November 19th

Your Journey Begins

Set your heart on pilgrimage as you depart for the lands where faith was born. Ahead awaits a tapestry of history, revelation, and breathtaking encounters.



Day 2 | Friday, November 20th

Welcome to the Land of the Pharaohs

Arrive in Cairo, gateway to one of the world's oldest civilizations. Gather for an uplifting opening dinner as we prepare to explore lands once walked by Joseph, Moses, and the children of Israel.



Day 3 | Saturday, November 21st

Worship & Ancient Christian Heritage

Celebrate the Sabbath in the vibrant community of Heliopolis. Walk through the ancient Coptic quarter, where early Christians preserved their faith through centuries of challenge. At the NMEC Museum, glimpse Egypt's millennia-old story—setting the stage for the biblical drama of the Exodus. If time allows, enjoy a quiet moment along the storied Nile River, where Moses was drawn from the water and destiny began.



Day 4 | Sunday, November 22nd

The Wonders of Giza & the Road to Sinai

Stand before the majestic Pyramids of Giza, ancient sentinels that towered long before Abraham walked the earth. Experience the fragrances and craftsmanship of Egypt through visits to a perfume atelier and papyrus workshop. Then begin the dramatic journey toward Mount Sinai, following in the path of the Israelites as they left Egypt for the mountain of God.



Day 5 | Monday, November 23rd

Sacred Sunrise on Mount Sinai & Red Sea Beauty

Ascend Mount Sinai in the quiet of the early morning, reaching the summit as the sun warms the horizon. Here, where Moses received the Ten Commandments, feel the weight of divine history echoing across the peaks. After this mountaintop encounter, descend toward the shimmering shores of the Red Sea, a reminder of the miraculous crossing that changed Israel's destiny.



Day 6 | Tuesday, November 24th

Into the Land of Promise

Travel north to Taba and cross into Israel—the Promised Land of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Step into the desert sanctuary at Timna Park, where a full-scale model of the biblical Tabernacle reveals the beauty and symbolism of God's dwelling place among His people. Continue to Bethlehem, birthplace of hope and fulfillment of prophecy.



Day 7 | Wednesday, November 25th

From Herod's Coast to the Galilee of Jesus

Explore Caesarea, where the Gospel reached the Gentiles through Peter and Paul. At Mount Carmel, recall Elijah's dramatic confrontation with the prophets of Baal. Enter Nazareth, where Jesus grew, learned, and lived among His people. End the day with a peaceful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, imagining the miracles and teachings that once calmed these same waters.



Day 8 | Thursday, November 26th

Galilee: Heart of Jesus' Ministry

Experience the serenity of the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus spoke the words that changed the world. Visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, recalling Christ's restoration of His disciple. Walk among the ruins of Capernaum, the town Jesus called His own. Discover Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene, and conclude with a visit to Yardenit, a meaningful site of baptism and renewal.



Day 9 | Friday, November 27th

Strongholds, Scrolls & the Lowest Place on Earth

Climb the mighty stronghold of Masada, where courage stood against empire. At Qumran, learn how the Dead Sea Scrolls preserved Scripture through the ages. Feel the healing buoyancy of the Dead Sea, a landscape unlike anywhere on earth. If time allows, visit Jericho, the world's oldest city and the site of Joshua's miraculous victory. In the evening, welcome the Sabbath at the Western Wall, surrounded by prayer, praise, and the heartbeat of ancient Jerusalem.



Day 10 | Saturday, November 28th

Sacred Jerusalem

Begin at the tranquil Garden Tomb, a powerful reminder of resurrection hope. Walk the Mount of Olives, where Jesus ascended to heaven; pause in Gethsemane, where He prayed in deep surrender; and follow the Via Dolorosa, retracing His final steps. In the afternoon, visit Bethany, home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus—a place of friendship, faith, and miracle.



Day 11 | Sunday, November 29th

Exploring the City of David

Enter the Upper Room, recalling the Last Supper and the birth of the early church. Visit David's Tomb, honoring Israel's beloved king and psalmist. Stand atop the revered Temple Mount, the center of Jewish worship through the ages. Descend through Hezekiah's Tunnel, carved in ancient times, and emerge at the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus restored sight to the blind.



Day 12 | Monday, November 30th

Farewell to the Holy Lands

Depart with hearts full and spirits renewed—carrying home the stories, teachings, and sacred memories of your journey through Egypt, Sinai, and Israel.

Day 1 | Tuesday, December 1st

Crossing Into Jordan & Baptism Sites of Scripture

Cross the border into Jordan, following the ancient routes traveled by prophets and pilgrims for generations. Visit Elijah's Hill, traditionally associated with the prophet Elijah's ascent into heaven. Continue to Bethany Beyond the Jordan, the authentic site where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. As you stand along the quiet waters of the Jordan River, reflect on the moment when heaven opened and the Spirit descended like a dove.



Day 2 | Wednesday, December 2nd

Petra: The Rose-Red Wonder & the Desert of Wadi Rum

Explore the magnificent city of Petra, carved into rose-colored cliffs by the Nabateans. Walk through the narrow Siq until the iconic Treasury comes into view, then continue deeper into this remarkable archaeological wonder richly connected to the lands of Edom and ancient trade routes. In the afternoon, travel to the sweeping landscapes of Wadi Rum, a silent desert of immense beauty. Its red sands and towering formations echo the journeys of Moses and the wanderings of desert peoples through the ages.



Day 3 | Thursday, December 3rd

Mount Nebo & the Mosaic City of Madaba

Ascend to Mount Nebo, the very place where Moses stood and viewed the Promised Land. Take in the panoramic vista stretching toward Jericho, the Jordan Valley, and the distant hills of Jerusalem—an unforgettable moment of biblical reflection. If time allows, visit Madaba, home to the famous 6th-century mosaic map of the Holy Land, a masterpiece that offers insight into early Christian geography and devotion.



Day 4 | Friday, December 4th

Departure from Jordan

Bid farewell to the Kingdom of Jordan with memories enriched by sacred history, awe-inspiring landscapes, and powerful biblical connections as you begin your journey home.
