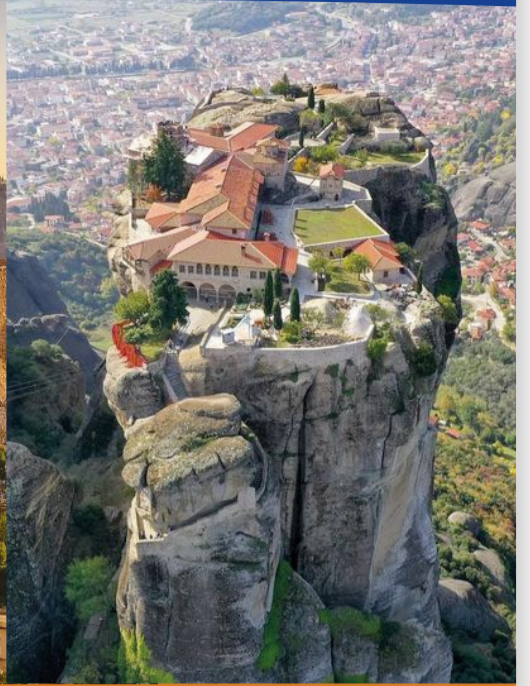

# Itinerary Main Tour

Gain greater insight into the history, geography and unique features of this historic, biblical places.



## Day 1 | Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>

### Departure

It's finally Departure Day for the Main Tour! Get ready to explore new destinations, make unforgettable memories, and embark on the journey of a lifetime. From the moment you step on board, excitement will be in the air! Pack your bags, grab your passport, and let's hit the road! Your next great adventure starts today.



## Day 2 | Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup>

### Arrival in Athens

Upon arrival in Athens, if time allows, we will enjoy some sightseeing to catch a glimpse of this historic city where Paul once preached. In the afternoon, we will make our way to the port of Piraeus to board the evening ferry—departing around 6:00 p.m.—for our overnight journey to the beautiful island of Patmos.



## Day 3 | Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>

### Patmos: The Island of Revelation

Departing from Skala harbor, our tour will start by visiting the Grotto of St. John taking the form of a 17th century Monastery built around the cave where St. John spent two years living the life of an ascetic (95-97 AD). Under the influence of visions, St. John wrote the Apocalypse, dictating it to his disciple Prochoros. We then drive up to the most impressive village of Chora, the capital of the island. On top of the hill, lies the Monastery of St. John, a Byzantine building, built in 1088 by the Blessed Christodoulos, servant of Christ. Overnight in Patmos.



## Day 4 | Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>

### Patmos Highlights

This day our tour, covering the south side of the island, not only giving you the opportunity of discovering hidden places but also an opportunity to photograph the most amazing land and seascapes. Our tour commences from the Port of Skala where we will be taken by bus to the old village of Chora, the island's capital and a photographer's paradise! We continue with a drive to the top of the mountain of Profit Ilias, the highest point of the island - 269 meters above sea level where the panoramic sea and landscape views leave one speechless! Next we make our descending drive to Diakofti stopping off to photograph the view of the mystical rock of Petra and then on to a boatyard. An unforgettable experience - you will have a memory of Patmos and its life, recorded through your own personal experience. Return to the Port of Skala. Overnight in ship (option to upgrade to cabins with shower and bathroom for \$150 per person) on Blue Star Ferry



## Day 5 | Thursday, May 21<sup>st</sup>

### Meteora Monasteries

Early this morning we arrive in Piraeus and journey north through the Greek countryside toward Meteora. Along the way, enjoy the changing landscapes that lead us to one of the most breathtaking places in all of Greece. Meteora, with its towering rock pillars that rise dramatically toward the sky, has long been a place of prayer and solitude. As we take in the sight of the monasteries that crown these cliffs—silent witnesses to centuries of faith and devotion—we are invited to pause, reflect, and be lifted heavenward. Overnight in Meteora.



## Day 6 | Friday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>

### Veria, Thessaloniki & Kavala

As you tour Thessaloniki, feel the spiritual essence of its rich history. At Vatopedion Monastery, where Paul once preached, reflect on the enduring power of faith. The White Tower and Alexander Monument stand as symbols of strength and legacy, reminding us of the balance between earthly achievements and divine purpose. In Veria Monastery, embrace the serenity of a sacred space touched by centuries of devotion. This journey through Thessaloniki invites you to deepen your connection to faith and history, walking paths that have inspired countless pilgrims before you. In the afternoon we will travel to Kavala, the historic port where Paul brought his message of hope to Europe, invites you to embrace gratitude and faith, inspired by the landscapes and legacies that shaped this sacred path. Overnight in Kavala



## Day 7 | Saturday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>

### Philippi & Spiritual Reflection

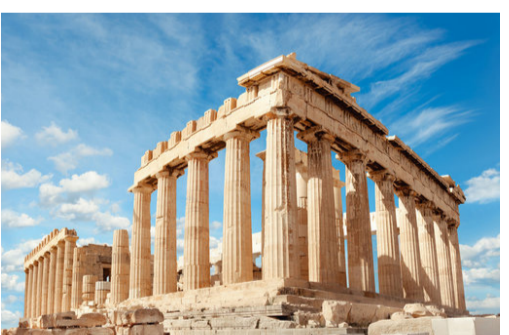

### Corinth & Cencreae

Today, as you visit the Corinth Canal, Ancient Corinth, and Cencreae, immerse yourself in their spiritual significance. The canal symbolizes bold paths forged with faith, while Ancient Corinth echoes Paul's timeless teachings. At Cencreae, the peaceful port reminds us of purposeful journeys and the grace guiding our lives. Overnight in Athens.
