Itinerary Main Tour

Gain greater insight into the history, geography and unique features of these historic, biblical places.



Day 1 | Sunday, April 4th

It's finally Departure Day for the Main Tour! Get ready to explore new destinations, make unforgettable memories, and embark on the journey of a lifetime. From the moment you step on board, excitement will fill the air. Pack your bags, grab your passport, and prepare your heart for an unforgettable journey through the lands where history and faith come alive.



Day 2 | Monday, April 5th

Welcome to Athens (ATH), the cradle of Western civilization. Upon arrival, discover the city's most iconic landmarks, including Syntagma Square, the Panathenaic Stadium, Hadrian's Arch, and Lycabettus Hill, offering spectacular views over the city. Later, visit the Acropolis and stand on Mars Hill, where the Apostle Paul boldly shared the Gospel, reflecting on a message that continues to inspire believers today.



Day 3 | Tuesday, April 6th

Today, journey to Corinth, a city closely connected to the ministry of the Apostle Paul. Stop at the impressive Corinth Canal before exploring Ancient Corinth, where Paul preached and established a thriving Christian community. Visit Acrocorinth and Cenchreae, the port from which Paul continued his missionary journeys, reflecting on a life devoted to sharing the Gospel.



Day 4 | Wednesday, April 7th

As you travel north, pause at the Monument of Leonidas before arriving in the breathtaking region of Meteora. Marvel at its magnificent monasteries, perched high upon towering rock formations as a testimony of faith, perseverance, and devotion. Spend the evening surrounded by one of Greece's most inspiring landscapes.



Day 5 | Thursday, April 8th

Begin the day in Veria (Berea), where the noble Bereans eagerly searched the Scriptures after hearing Paul's message. Continue to Thessaloniki, where Paul ministered to one of the early Christian churches. Explore the city's historic landmarks while reflecting on the enduring faith that spread throughout this important biblical city.



Day 6 | Friday, April 9th

Travel through northern Greece, stopping at the Lion of Amphipolis before continuing to the regions of Drama and Kavala. In Kavala, traditionally identified as ancient Neapolis, stand where the Apostle Paul first set foot in Europe, marking the beginning of the Gospel's spread across the continent. End the day with Sabbath Vespers.



Day 7 | Saturday, April 10th

Walk in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul as you visit Ancient Philippi, where he established one of Europe's first Christian churches. Reflect at Lydia's Baptistery, commemorating the first recorded Christian baptism in Europe. After lunch, enjoy a peaceful Sabbath Afternoon Walk, taking time to reflect on the beauty of God's creation and the blessings of the Sabbath. As the day comes to a close, gather once again for Sunset Vespers, celebrating a meaningful Sabbath surrounded by unforgettable memories.



Day 8 | Sunday, April 11th

Today we say farewell as we depart from Thessaloniki Airport or continue with the Post Extension. As your journey comes to an end, take with you the lessons, friendships, and spiritual experiences gathered while following in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul. Day 1 | Thursday | April 1st

Day 2 | Friday | April 2nd



Arrival in Athens-Transfer to Piraeus port where a boat will take you to your Patmos experience. Ferry leaves at nearly 6 pm. Late arrival in Patmos Island.

Day 3 | Saturday | April 3rd



Departing from Skala harbor, our tour will start by visiting the Grotto of St. John taking the form of a 17th century Monastery built around the cave where St. John spent two years living the life of an ascetic (95-97 AD). Under the influence of visions, St John wrote the Apocalypse, dictating it to his disciple Prochoros. We then drive up to the most impressive village of Chora, the capital of the island. On top of the hill, lies the Monastery of St. John, a Byzantine building, built in 1088 by the Blessed Christodoulos, servant of Christ. Overnight in Patmos.

Day 4 | Sunday | April 4th



This day our tour, covering the south side of the island, not only giving you the opportunity of discovering hidden places but also an opportunity to photograph the most amazing land and seascapes. You will visit the old village of Chora, and continue to the top of the mountain of Profit Illias, the highest point of the island - 269 meters above sea level, where the panoramic sea and landscape views leave one speechless! Next we make our descending drive to Diakofti stopping off to photograph the view of the mystical rock of Petra. Overnight in ship back to Athens to start the Main tour.

Arriving at Piraeus Port at nearly 8:25 am. Transfer to Athens to start the Main tour

Day 1 | Sunday | April 11th

Arrive in Santorini Prepare to be Enchanted! If time allows, in the afternoon visit the remarkable Akrotiri Lighthouse, marvel at the ocean views from Firostefani and Skaro Rock, and watch the sunset over the picturesque village of Oia. Free time.

Day 2 | Monday | April 12th



You will enjoy a Santorini Volcano and Hot Springs Boat Tour where you will visit the island of Palaia Kammeni and visit the hot springs, the famous mud baths, which were formed as result of a series of volcanic eruptions. In the small bay of Agios Nikolaos the water temperature ranges from 30 to 35 degrees Celsius, as it mixes continuously with the normal sea currents. You will have free time in the late afternoon to enjoy the enchanting sunset and views of Santorini.

Day 3 | Tuesday | April 13th



Spend a full day discovering Santorini's ancient story, local culture, and famous views on this great-value highlights tour. Explore the Santorinian villages, visit the Red Beach, swim at the black-sand Perissa Beach, take in panoramic views from Prophet Elias Monastery, and learn details about the historical heritage of the island. Finish the day with an unforgettable sunset from Oia village.

Day 4 | Wednesday | April 14th



End of the Tour, fly back home from Santorini. As your journey ends, take a moment to reflect on the spiritual connections and sacred history you've experienced. May the lessons and memories from this trip stay with you, guiding you on your way home.
