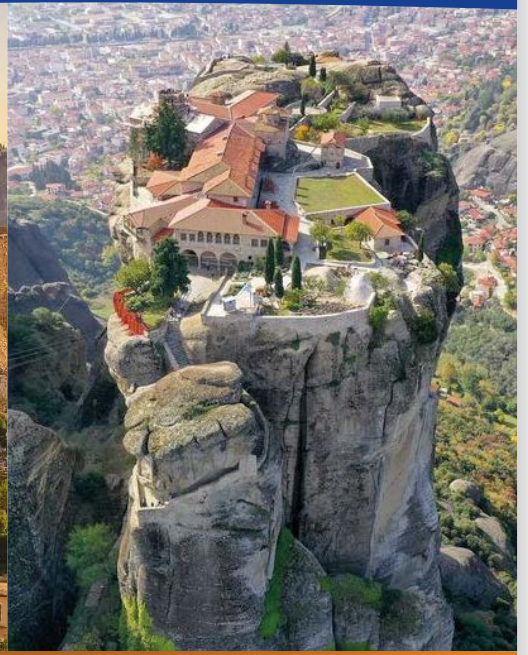

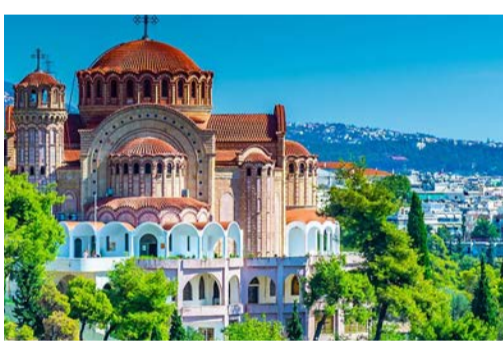
Day 5 | Monday, May 3rd

As you journey to Meteora and explore its ancient monasteries, feel the profound presence of the divine that permeates this sacred land. The White Tower and Alexander Monument stand as symbols of strength and legacy, reminding us of the balance between earthly achievements and divine purpose. In Veria Monastery, embrace the serenity of a sacred space touched by centuries of devotion. This journey through Thessaloniki invites you to deepen your connection to faith and history, walking paths that have inspired countless pilgrims before you. In the afternoon we will travel to Kavala, the historic port where Paul brought his message of hope to Europe, invites you to embrace gratitude and faith, inspired by the landscapes and legacies that shaped this sacred path. Day 8 | Thursday, May 6th

During this day, as you tour Ancient Philippi, walk in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul, where faith first took root in Europe. At the House of Lydia, reflect on her role as the first Christian convert and the power of new beginnings. In Ancient Kavala, admire the harmony of history and faith in a city that has connected cultures for centuries. Day 1 | Tuesday, April 27th

Arrive in Santorini Prepare to be Enchanted! If time allows, in the afternoon visit the remarkable Akrotiri Lighthouse, marvel at the ocean views from Firostefani and Skaro Rock, and watch the sunset over the picturesque village of Oia. Free time.



Day 2 | Wednesday, April 28th

You will enjoy a Santorini Volcano and Hot Springs Boat Tour where you will visit the island of Palaia Kammeni and visit the hot springs, the famous mud baths, which were formed as result of a series of volcanic eruptions. In the small bay of Agios Nikolaos the water temperature ranges from 30 to 35 degrees Celsius, as it mixes continuously with the normal sea currents. You will have free time in the late afternoon to enjoy the enchanting sunset and views of Santorini.



Day 3 | Thursday, April 29th

Spend a full day discovering Santorini's ancient history, local culture, and famous views on this great-value highlights tour. Explore the Santorinian villages, visit the Red Beach, swim at the black-sand Perissa Beach, take in panoramic views from Prophet Elias Monastery, and learn details about the historical heritage of the island. Finish the day with an unforgettable sunset from Oia village.



Day 4 | Friday, April 30th

Late Morning departure to Athens. Rest and Relax and prepare to begin main tour.

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Day 1 | Friday, May 7th

Start the Post-Extension to the beautiful isle of Patmos. Travel from Athens to Piraeus to take the Ferry to Patmos. Ferry leave at nearly 6 pm.



Day 2 | Saturday, May 8th

Departing from Skala harbor, our tour will start by visiting the Grotto of St. John taking the form of a 17th century Monastery built around the cave where St. John spent two years living the life of an ascetic (95-97 AD). Under the influence of visions, St John wrote the Apocalypse, dictating it to his disciple Prochoros. We then drive up to the most impressive village of Chora, the capital of the island. On top of the hill, lies the Monastery of St. John, a Byzantine building, built in 1088 by the Blessed Christodoulos, servant of Christ. Dinner and worship*. Overnight in Patmos.



Day 3 | Sunday, May 9th

This day our tour, covering the south side of the island, not only giving you the opportunity of discovering hidden places but also an opportunity to photograph the most amazing land and seascapes. Our tour commences from the Port of Skala where we will be taken by bus to the old village of Chora, the island's capital and a photographer's paradise! We continue with a drive to the top of the mountain of Profit Ilias, the highest point of the island - 269 meters above sea level where the panoramic sea and landscape views leave one speechless! Next we make our descending drive to Diakofti stopping off to photograph the view of the mystical rock of Petra and then on to a boatyard. An unforgettable experience - you will have a memory of Patmos and its life, recorded through your own personal experience.. Return to the Port of Skala. Overnight in ship (option to upgrade to cabins with shower and bathroom for \$150 per person) on Blue Star Ferry.



Day 4 | Monday, May 10th

Arriving at Piraeus Port at nearly 8:25 am. Transfer to Athens. Departure afternoon flight from Athens airport

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
