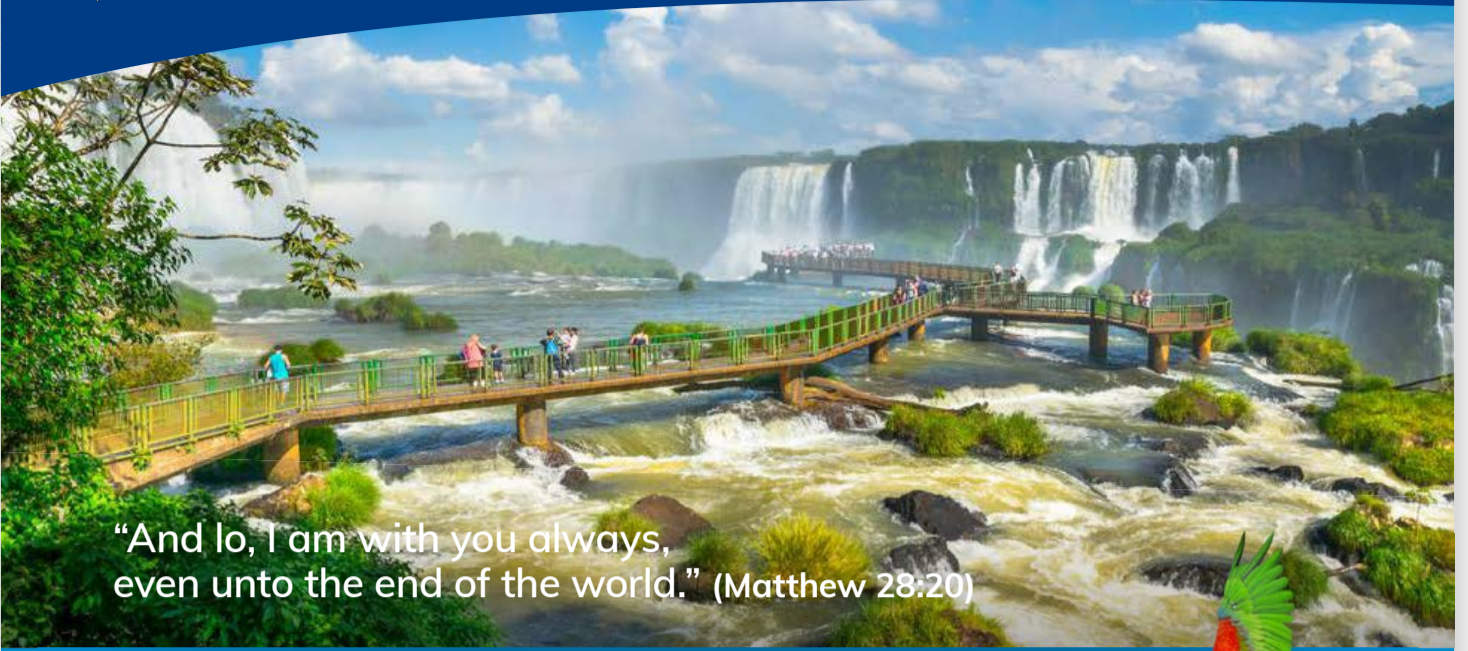

Day 1 | Sunday, August 1st

Depart for Brazil

Fly to El Calafate

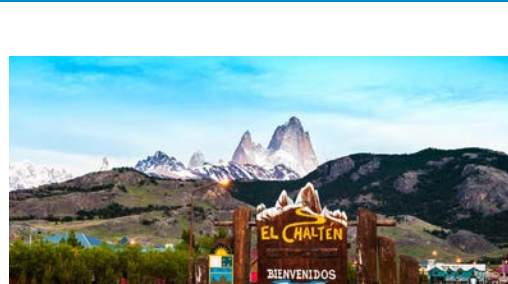

Fly to Ushuaia

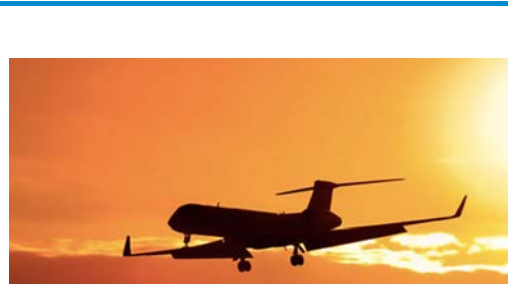
